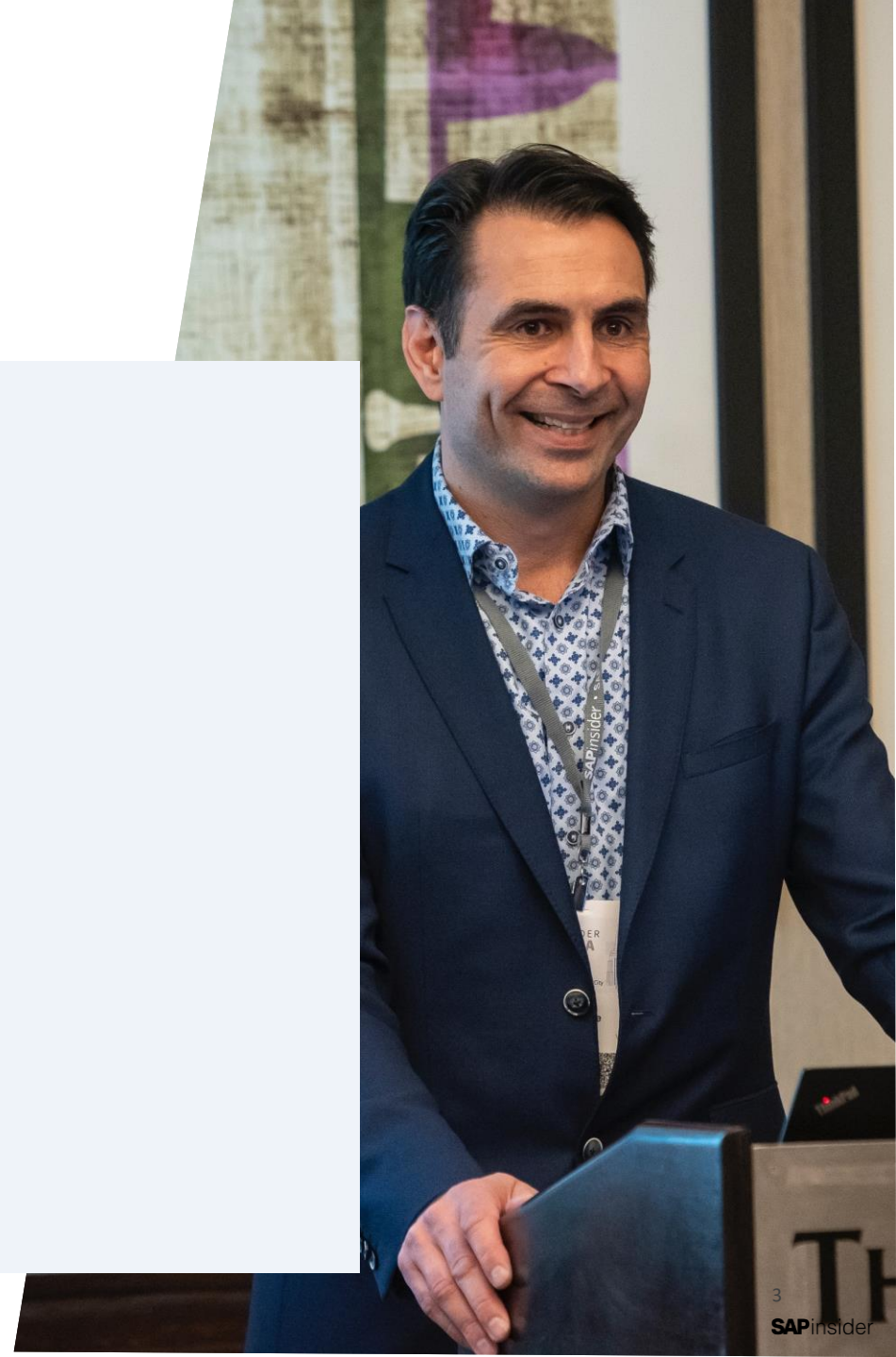

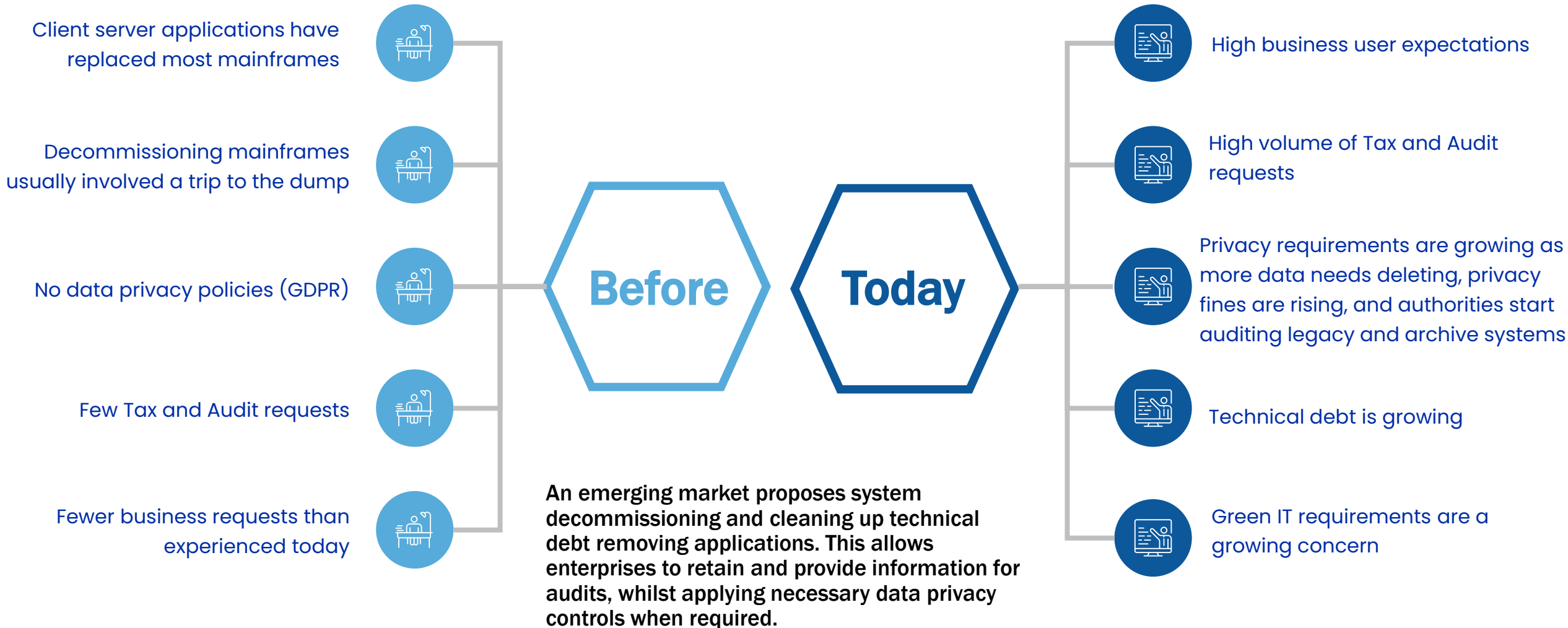

Why is system decommissioning becoming an emerging IT approach ?

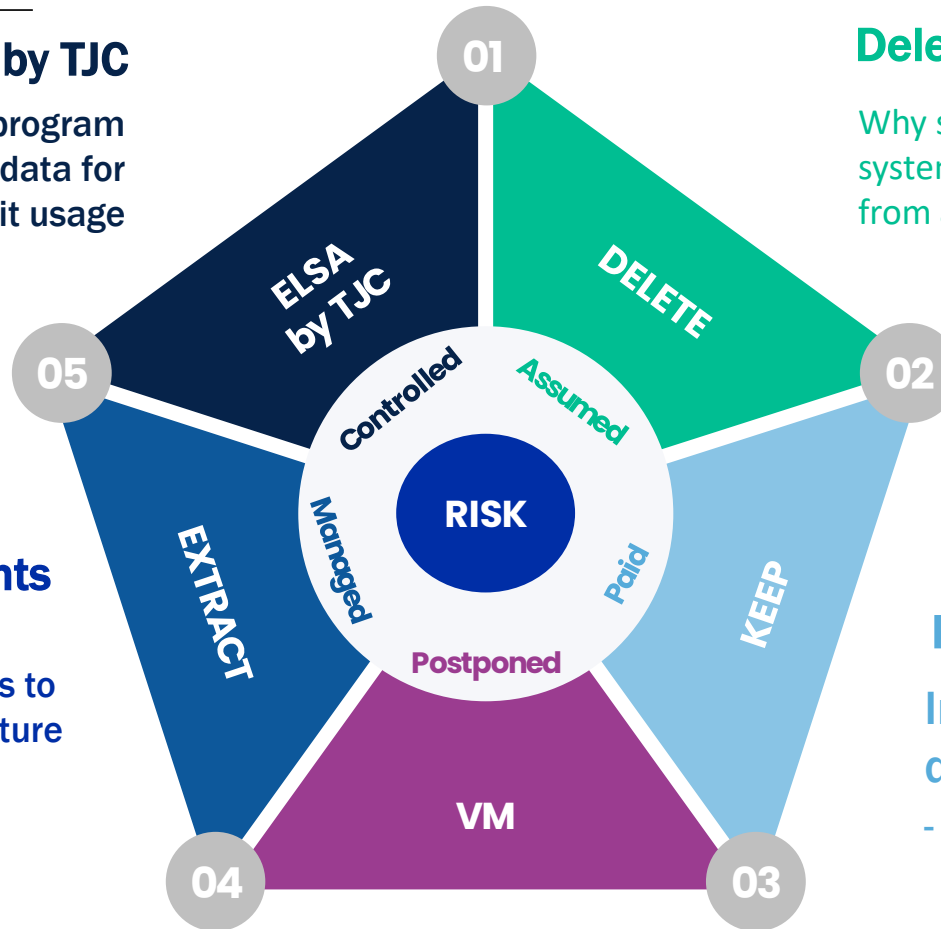


Options available

ELSA (Access) by TJC
Set up a decommissioning program securing access to legacy data for business and tax & audit usage

No real need for business users to access legacy content in the future

Why spending money on old Legacy systems when the content is outdated from a compliance point of view?

Keep your Legacy System

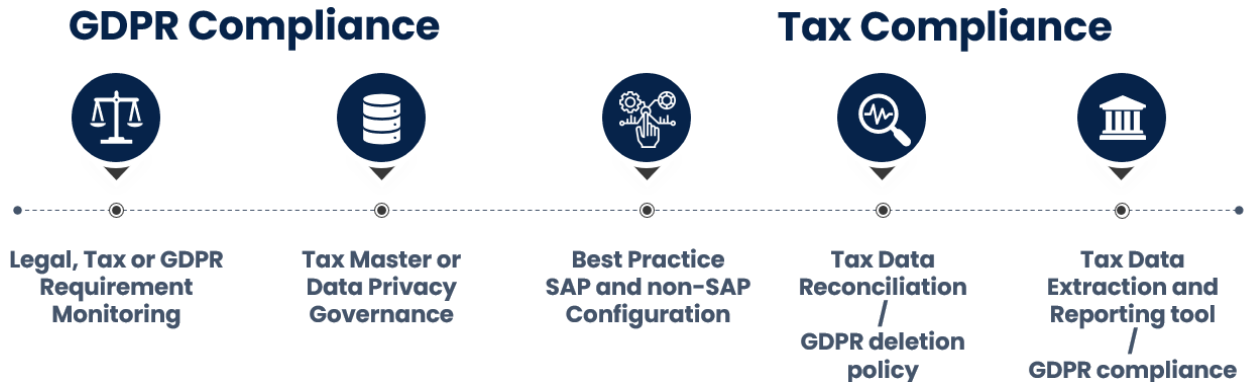
In some cases, the best strategy is to do nothing:

- Keep the system for 2 years before deleting it completely as it won't be needed for compliance reasons.
- IF a tax review is due any time soon

Virtual Machine

Host the full Legacy system within a VM

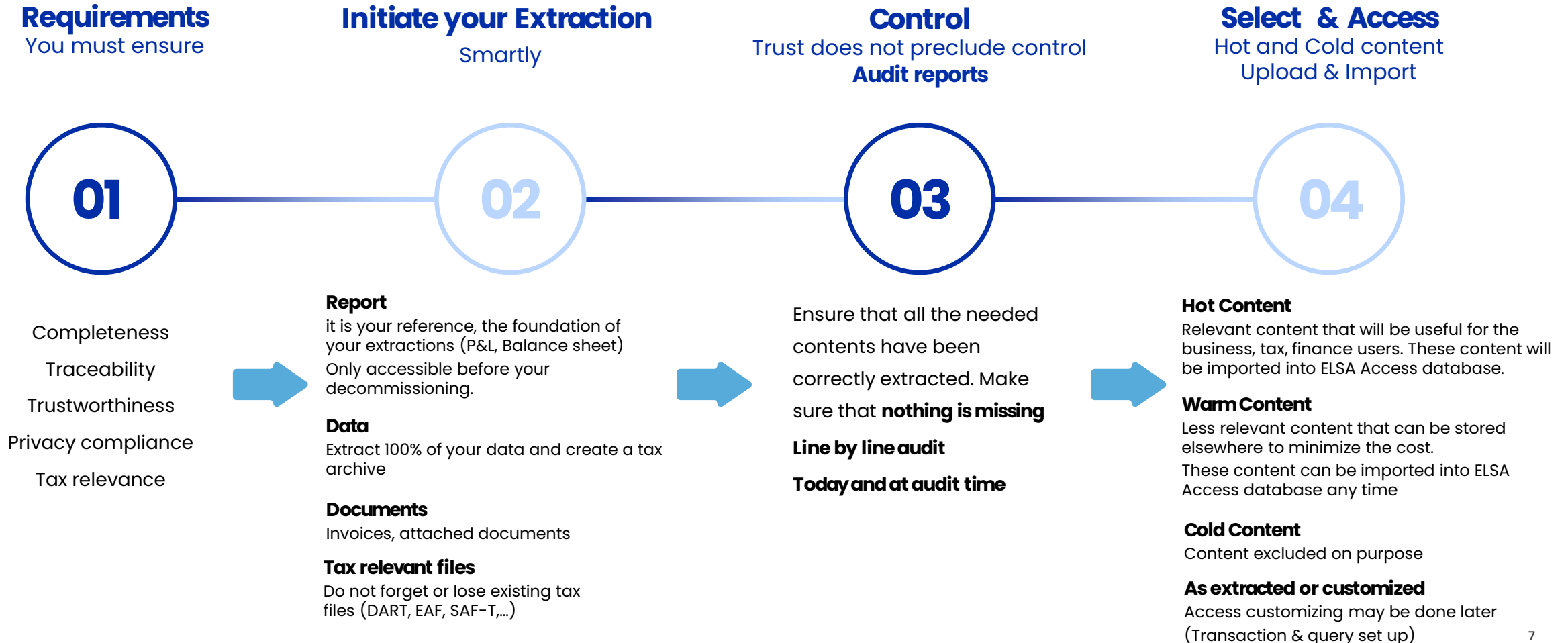
System documentation

- The programs (project doc, user doc, configuration doc, source code specific)

Extract 100% of the content of the Legacy system to archive and **store it as a tax archive (flat file)**

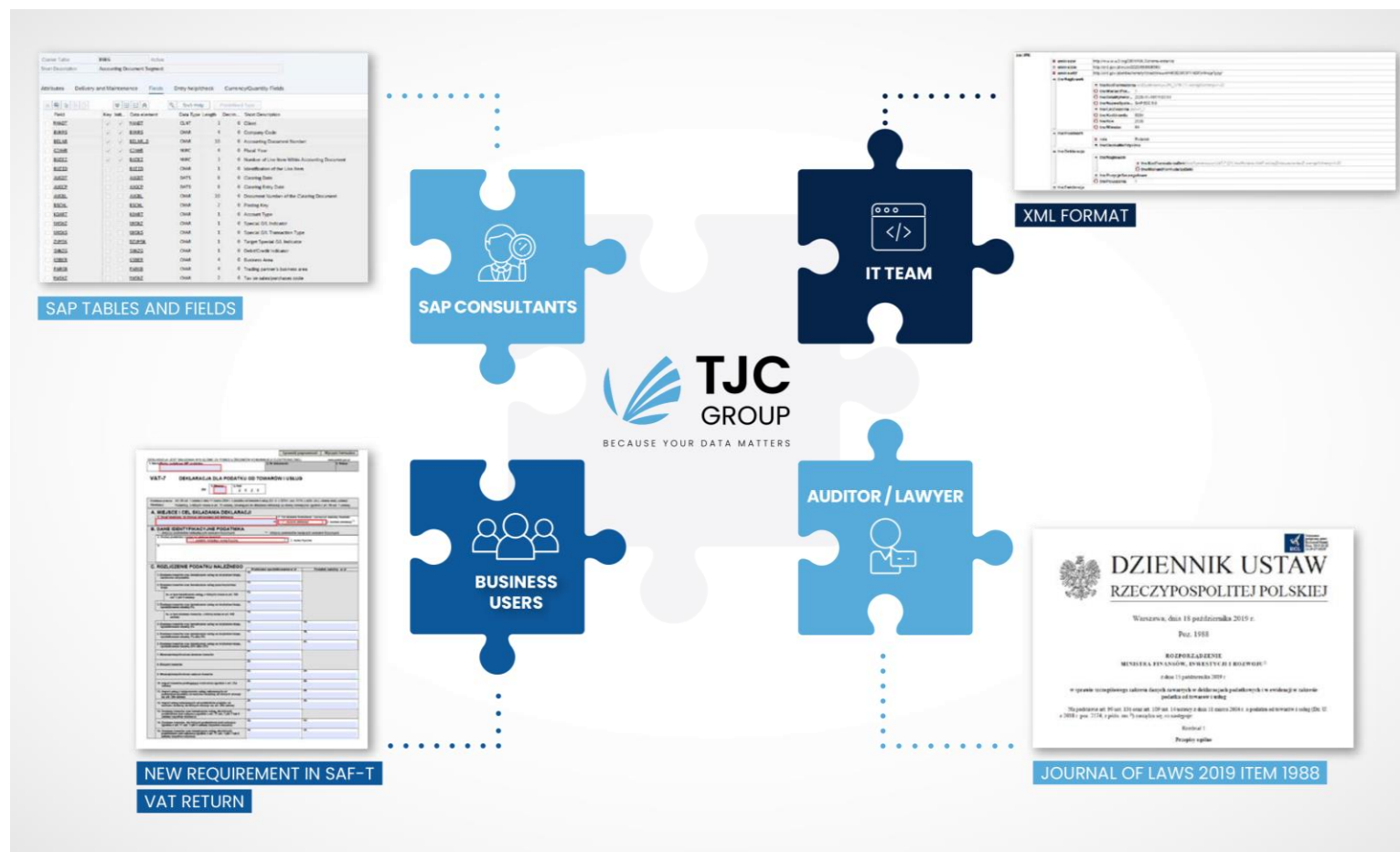
